December 11, 1932 - January 7, 2022

Enrique Lutao San Jose, 89, of Orlando Florida, passed away on January 7th, 2022 after a long battle with Parkinson's disease.

Enrique, who often went by "Joe," was born on December 11th in 1932 to Pascual and Fermina San Jose in Bayugo, Meycauayan, Bulacan in the Phillipines. He was 1 of 6 children. At a young age, Joe joined the United States Navy, left the Phillipines, and eventually graduated from Submariner school in 1959. He served 20+ years in the United States Navy and Reserves.

When stationed in Naples, Italy in 1965, the Filipino American Naval soldier met the love of his life, Vanda Maria Ciuccio, at her then family-owned business. They fell in love, and as he was being redeployed, he vowed to come back for her. They were married for over 54 years. He is survived by his wife, Vanda Maria San Jose, 2 daughters: Rosalinda San Jose and Lilliana Leighton, and son: Ricardo San Jose. He has 3 grandchildren: Austin Ray Jasper, Cole Anthony Jasper, and Arianna Jones.

He was a devout husband, father and family-man, and was always the life of the party. He had a passion for sports, family, comedy, dancing, singing, and entertaining. With a crooner's voice, comedian's wit, and Fred Astaire's danceability, Joe glided thru life and brightened every room he entered. He will be deeply missed, never forgotten, and always honored.
