



## Hannah Lee Walker

March 7, 1925 - April 13, 2022

Hannah Lee Walker, 97, died on April 13, 2022 at her home in Orlando, Florida. She was born an identical twin with her beloved sister Ceacil Eisner in Pittsburgh, Pennsylvania, the daughter of Morris Eisner, an engineer with Bethlehem Steel, and Rachel Leib Eisner, a dressmaker.

After marrying Alexander Walker, a dentist, in 1944, she won a scholarship to Columbia

University to study sculpture with William Zorach and Oronzio Maldarelli.

While raising her children she helped her husband in his practice and continued to make art. In 1979 she moved to Orlando with her husband and sister. After her husband's death in 1980 she became deeply involved with the arts activities at the Lime Tree Club of Williamsburg, where she lived. She made scenery and costumes for the theater group and posters and decorations for social events. She continued to draw, sculpt, paint and work in ceramics till almost the end of her life.

She leaves a son, Todd Walker of Sacramento, California, and a daughter, Wendy Walker of Brooklyn, New York.
