Jill Jane Galloway Strout passed away April 9, 2022 after a long battle with Alzheimer's Disease and side effects from Covid-19. Ms. Strout was born in Battle Creek, Michigan on October 7, 1946 and moved to Orlando FL when she was in grade school and remained a resident of Orlando after returning from working with AAFES in Germany. Ms. Strout also worked for the City of Orlando, Orange County Water Reclamation and served on the City of Orlando Historic Preservation Board. Ms. Strout was a huge advocate for the voiceless and gave her time and money to support many organizations. She lived her life in a way to lead quietly by example, giving her time generously to others. One of the many examples of her giving is when Ms. Strout and her family were one of the first families to sponsor a Vietnamese family after Howard Strout returned from two tours in Vietnam serving in the Marines.

Ms. Strout loved traveling worldwide, amazing food, and really good dark chocolate.

She loved her children: Glenn, Holly, Elizabeth and Patricia and absolutely adored her grandchildren: Richard, Colin, Alison and Hannah. She was a resilient and resourceful woman who didn't readily take no for an answer, and made sure her children knew how to navigate the world in a way that would help them succeed in the best way possible. She made sure to always seek out the best opportunities for her children.
