October 26, 1934 - January 11, 2023

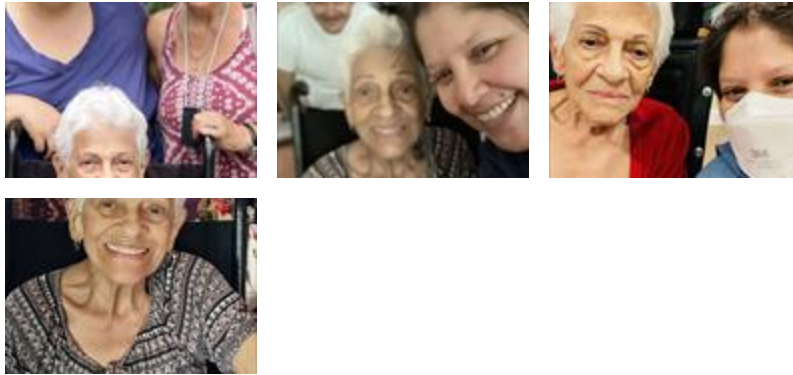

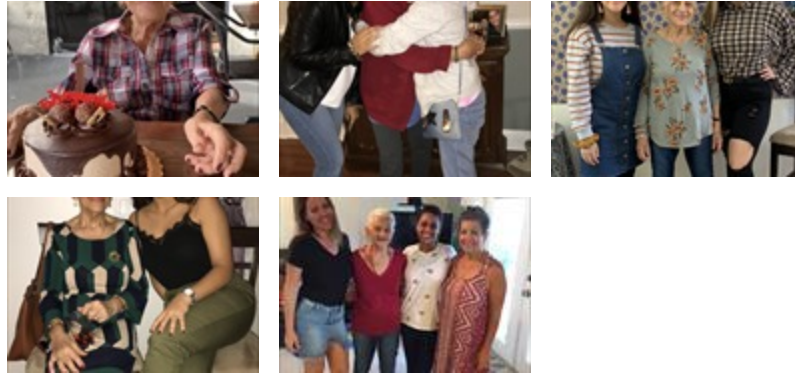

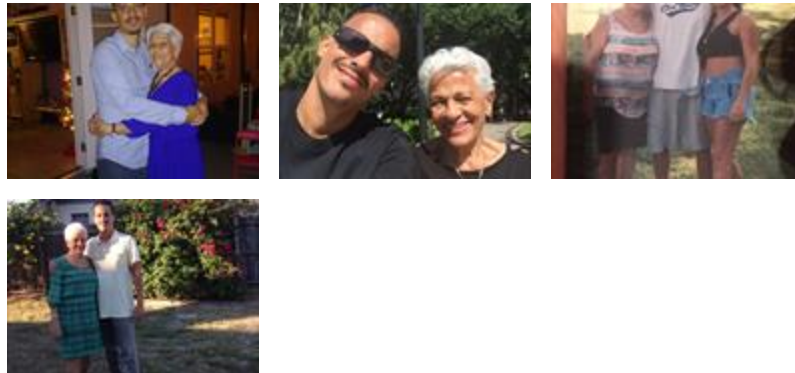
